New microcontroller System supervisor

Due to component availability issues, the STM32 system supervisor microcontroller in CCpilot V700 is upgraded to a later generation of the same microcontroller.

The new microcontroller is pin compatible meaning that it will be no change to the PCB. The new microcontroller may consume less power but should otherwise be like the previous version. It will require an updated SS software as described below.

New SW

Related to the hardware change there is a need to update the SS software.

Changes in software v2.X compared to the previous v1.X

- Added support for new microcontroller (STM32L452V***)
- Improved buzzer sound quality
- Disabled support for old microcontroller (STM32F091R***)



Recommendation

Note: Do not downgrade units with revision < 1.1 using older versions of SS Software Older units with revision < 1.1 must not be updated with the new SS Software as it is not supporting the old STM microcontroller.

Improper software can damage your device.
